

**Saturday, 9. – Saturday, 23. July 2016**

Members of the RC Neustadt Vohburg upon the river Danube will host 20 girls and boys from the age of 16 to 18 at their homes. Neustadt is located 100 km north of the Bavarian Capital Munich. The area is mostly flat with small hills. Therefore the Summercamp-Participants will use on three or four days bicycles to get around. Participants must have some cycling experience and should be able to cycle a maximum of 30 km per day.

The Camp will focus on visiting historical sites and towns such as Regensburg, Ingolstadt and Munich. Too, local specialties and traditions can be studied during the visit of a beer festival or brewery. As the area is both strong in agriculture and industry, a refinery of crude oil as well as the Audi-car-plant and other companies will be visited.

Artificial lakes and the river Danube offer the possibility to recreate, enjoy bathing, boating, water-skiing and (hopefully) the Summer sun (so please do not forget swimwear).

All participants should possess good English skills. Most hosts speak English. Please mention, if you wish to improve your German in order to match you with suitable host-parents. We expect some curiosity in order to learn about the rich historical and industrial background of the region.

#### **Costs / Fees**

Travel expenses to Munich Airport or to the Train Stations in Regensburg or Ingolstadt. Participation fee of 100 Euros. Pocket money and insurance (see below) must be paid by the participants. The RC Neustadt Vohburg sponsors the cost of the whole stay and all activities.

#### **Accommodation**

In host families, in some cases two persons per room.

#### **Insurance**

A medical and liability insurance for the duration of the Summercamp in Bavaria will be provided by Rotary. Visa-travelers need an insurance of their own when applying for a visa.

#### **Language**

English during all activities and guided tours. Some hosts may not speak English on an academic level. Please specify if you prefer to speak German with your host family.

#### **Food, Smoking, Alcohol**

Standard German and European Food.

Smoking in the public is not permitted for under 18 years old.

Beer and wine may be consumed from the age of 16 years. Liquors / spirits may not be consumed by under 18 years old. Hosts will permit moderate consumption of beer and wine especially when visiting a brewery or beerfestival.

#### **Application**

Use the standard Rotary Short Term Application form. Deadline is Saturday, 30. April 2016. All applications received in time will be considered. Not more than two people per country will be accepted.
